August Sessions:

Sit In The Driver's Seat – Be the Reviewer

Step into the role of an NIH study section reviewer. Participants will receive materials in advance and be guided through a simulated scoring and critiquing of a previously-submitted K or R01 application. You'll apply NIH review criteria, develop summary statements, and learn how reviewers formulate and communicate feedback.

Be the Fly On the Wall – Observe a Study Section in Action

You'll walk away with valuable insight on how to prepare your own proposals to succeed in peer review.
